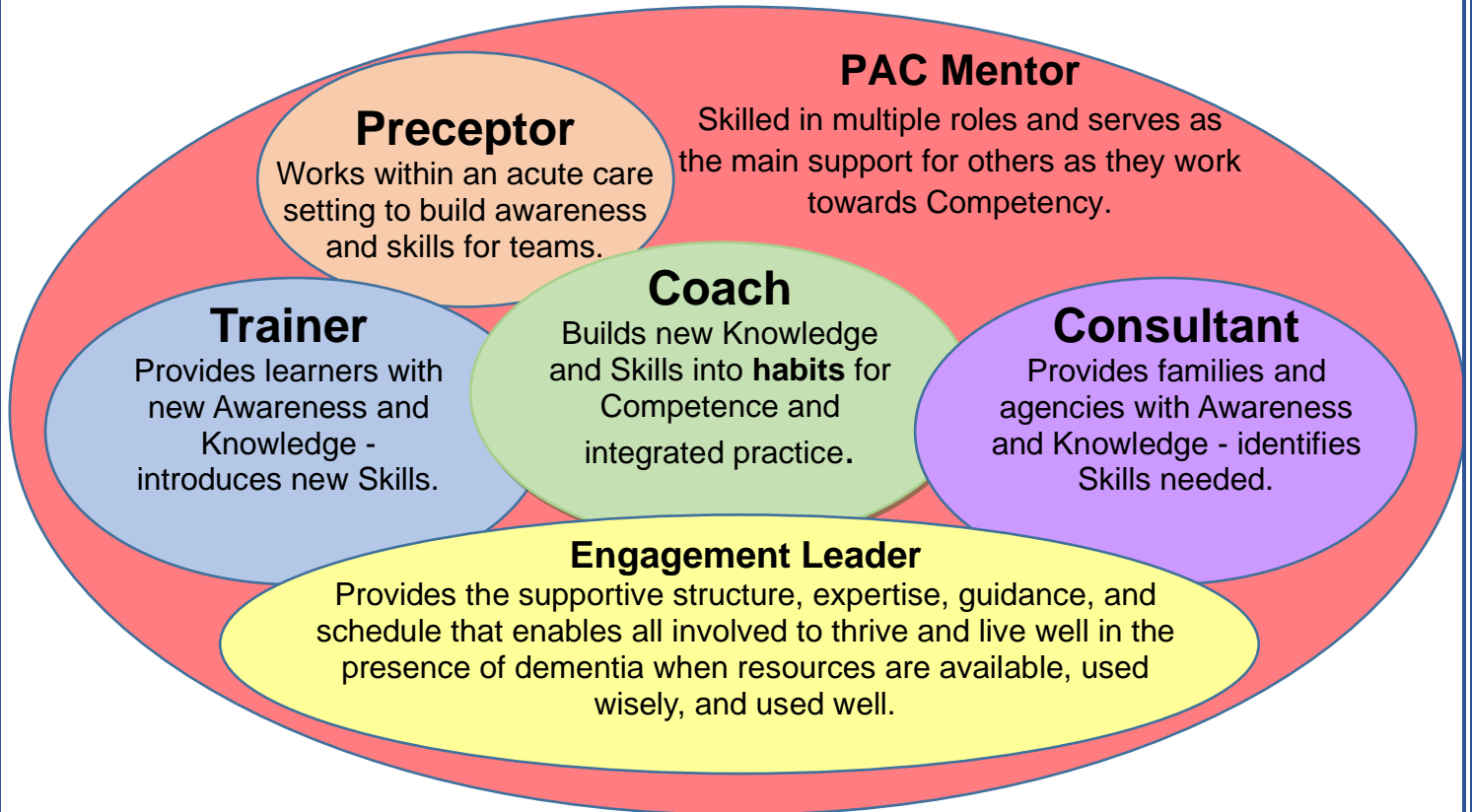

Next Steps – Earning Your PAC Trainer-Coach Certification:

The Independent Certified Positive Approach® to Care (PAC) Trainer and Coach course is designed to provide you with knowledge and skill that will allow you to build Teepa Snow's PAC philosophy, knowledge and skill use in others. The following steps will enable you to earn your Independent PAC Certified Trainer or Independent PAC Certified Coach designation. You will work with a PAC Mentor to complete the process. **This requires timely follow up on your part and completion of the steps below within 8 weeks of your classroom training.**

An Independent PAC Trainer will follow up with their PAC Mentor to complete the following skill-building plan in partnership with their Independent PAC Coach(es):

Pre-work for Week 1:

- Submit a video of you demonstrating PPA™ and HuH® with your **Coach** partner

Week 1:

- Post-class **Mentor call**, review material
- Review and self-evaluate your video demonstration of your PPA™ and HuH® skills

Week 2:

- Review and practice the trainer script for **Workshop A1: Normal Aging**
- Schedule training at your community for **Workshop A1**

- Discuss and role play at least 1 **use of the AELC in-the-moment** to respond to a learner question to demonstrate/practice Trainer skills Goal set for your own skill-building, training plan, and graduate

- Review and self-evaluate your demonstration of your PPA™ and HuH® skills and 1st coaching video with your **Trainer** partner

Week 2:

- Review and practice the Coach script for **Huddle A1: Normal Aging**
- Schedule your Coaching Huddles with learners for after the trainer workshop

Week 3:

- Coordinate with your **Trainer** partner to either attend or huddle after training to review objectives achieved during the workshop
- Practice, conduct, and record your Coaching Huddles with the learners from **Huddle A1**

Week 4:

- **Mentor call** to review and self-evaluate your Coaching Huddles from **Huddle A1**
- Schedule your Coaching Huddles with learners for after **Workshop A2**

Week 5:

- Practice, conduct, and record your Coaching Huddle with the learners from **Huddle A2: Intro to Hand-under-Hand®**

Week 6:

- **Mentor call** to review and self-evaluate your Coaching Huddles from **Huddle A2**
- Schedule your Coaching Huddles with learners for after **Workshop A3**
